

Bylaws of "Yes On Parks!", an Unincorporated social welfare Association

1. The name of the organization is "Yes On Parks!"
2. The specific purpose of this organization is to support funding for public parks in Santa Clara County within the meaning of Revenue and Taxation Code Section 23701f.
3. The Board of Directors consists of individuals who accept the Chair's invitation to join.

4. Officers:

The Officers are Chair, Treasurer, and Assistant Treasurer.

Officers are selected by majority consensus of the Board.

The term in office is not limited.

Board meetings are as called by the Chair. In the absence of a Chair, the Treasurer or Assistant Treasurer may call a meeting upon at least 48 hours' notice.


5. This organization is a nonprofit public benefit organization and is not organized for the private gain of any person.

6. Dedication clause:

The property of this organization is irrevocably dedicated to social welfare purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or private person.

7. Dissolution clause:

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the organization, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this organization shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for social welfare purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(4).
